The Project of Still Hopes for This Life "The 3rd Get-Together Fair for Families of Craniofacial Patients"

The Project of Still Hopes for This Life has been held since 2001 with the objectives of mental and social care for the patients and their families who are affected by harelip, hollowed palate, and other facial and skull disorders in addition to treatments with specialized operations. It is to give chances to this group of patients and their

families of getting together for sharing their



experiences and receiving mutual assistances under the close physician supervision to provide proper education for better understanding of their daily routine life and medical cares. One of the activities of this project is the Get-Together Fair which is held biannually for these patients and their families to get together in the same way as children without craniofacial deformities normally do on the National Children Day. This year the event



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will be third time after the two previously successes in 2006 and 2008.









Expected Benefits to the patients and their families

- 1. To be physically and mentally released from overwhelming troubles after attending the projected activities.
- 2. To get acquaintance and exchange experiences among them leading to building their social networks for living together with more meaningful and better quality of life.
- To get close contact to the medical team and consequently access to receiving proper cares and treatments in various services being offered by the Chulalongkorn Craniofacial Center.
- To enhance development of promoting social self- care among patients under the strategy of King Chulalongkorn Memorial Hospital in achieving excellency of services to patients.



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Programmes and Schedules

The programs will be held on Wednesday, 27th October 2010 at Dusit Zoo, 9.00-15.00 HRS.

7.00 The patients and their families with the accompany of the concerned staff will depart King Chulalongkorn Memorial Hospital, Thai Red Cross Society for Dusit Zoo.

9.00-9.30 Opening Ceremony by Khun Phaen Wannamethee, the Secretary General of the Thai Red Cross Society, followed up with reporting by Prof. Dr. Charan Mahathumarat, Head of the Princess Sirindhorn Craniofacial Center

9.30-11.30 Giving knowledge in general about the zoo, touring around the zoo by carriage

The zoo staffs will explain about the lives and characters of the animals concerned while travelling along. Patient attendants will be divided into two groups: group 1, ages 4-6 years old, about 40 persons; group 2, ages 7-13 years, about 40 in number. Both groups will be closely taken care by the staff of the zoo and volunteers at 2:1.
